

## Graduation Rate Outcomes

This report provides an overview of full-time, first-time students who entered Stony Brook University in Fall 2016 and their outcomes for completion, transfer and ongoing enrollment. These data fulfill in part the disclosure requirements of the Higher Education Opportunity Act.
