## **HTHW Shutdown Schedule May 2025**

Every year, right after Commencement, our Campus Operations and Maintenance team starts routine maintenance and repairs on the high-temperature hot water (HTHW) system. This system supplies hot water and heat to many campus buildings and needs to be shut down for scheduled repairs.

## **Phases of This Year's Project**

This year's four-phased approach to address needed repairs will safely restore the system to the greatest number of buildings in the shortest amount of time possible.

- Phase-1 (May 9<sup>th</sup> June 1<sup>st</sup>) No interruption of service.
- Phase-2 (May 24<sup>th</sup> at 6PM- June 1<sup>st</sup>) See map for affected buildings.
- Phase-3 (May 18<sup>th</sup> at 6PM- June 10<sup>th</sup>) See map for affected buildings.
- Phase-4 (June 13<sup>th</sup>- June 27<sup>th</sup>) See map for affected buildings

## **Non-Affected Buildings**

Not all buildings on the West campus use the high-temperature hot water (HTHW) system. Instead, some rely on their own internal heating equipment for space heating, hot water, or both. The following West campus buildings will not be affected by the HTHW shutdown:

- Computing Center
- East Side Dining
- Gray, Ammann, Irving and O'Neil Halls
- Island Federal Arena
- Athletic Indoor Practice Facility

- Schomburg Apartments
- Simons Center
- Sports Complex
- Starbucks
- West Apartment Complex
- Student Union

Additionally, the buildings on the South campus, West Apartments, and R&D Park will not be affected by the HTHW shutdown.
